ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

As the summer heat subsides to cooler temperatures, we prepare to welcome the Fall Season to the City of Rockford. With the Main Street project completed, we are turning our attention to new projects and opportunities. The City is currently working with a couple of new developers to bring projects forward in our community. The Tavern on the Crow planning process continues to move forward, with potential construction commencing in the Spring of 2017. We are also working with residential housing developers to help them prepare for potential new construction under consideration for 2017.

This October, the City will be partnering with the Rockford Greenfield Chamber of Commerce, the Rockford Area Historical Society and the Rockford Fire Department Auxiliary to bring a free concert to our community called "Rocktoberfest 2016, Celebrating 135 Years of Rockford History." This event will showcase six live bands, featuring local legends Shane Martin, Kat Perkins and G.B. Leighton.

City Staff are also working on improvements to the Riverside Park Hockey Rink, which includes installation of permanent boards, re-grading the lot for better ice quality, installation of fencing above the hockey boards and installation of lights to allow for evening use of the rink.

On behalf of all of us who work for the City of Rockford, we would like to thank you for your patience and sup-

port this past Summer during construction, and also for your continued support for our efforts and initiatives. As always, feel free to stop by City Hall if you have questions or would like to share any thoughts you may have.

S N O W S E A S O N P A R K I N G

During the period from **November 1st to April 1st** it shall be unlawful for any person to **park a vehicle** on or **within six feet of the roadway** between the hours of **2 a.m. to 6 a.m.** and anytime after there has been ice accumulation, continuous or intermittent snow fall during which there has been **accumulation of two inches or more** of snow on any street until plowed or removed the whole width of the roadway. Vehicles parked in violation of this ordinance will be towed and stored at the owner’s expense. **At NO TIME shall a vehicle be parked on ANY street for more than twelve (12) hours.**

SNOW PLOWING—It is unlawful to deposit snow onto **ANY city, township, county or state road.** Doing so is a violation of state statute and you will be fined.

The local elections in Rockford this year include two council members and the mayors seat. The terms for each of these positions are 4 years.

If you are a new resident to the City of Rockford, recently turned 18 or have not voted in the last four years, we encourage you to go online to www.sos.state.mn.us and complete a Voter Registration Application. You may also register to vote on Election Day, but make sure you have ID such as a current driver’s license or MN ID card with your correct address. If you have not changed your driver’s license you must have a current utility bill and your license. Last day to pre-register before the General Election is **October 18, 2016.**

Absentee voting begins **September 23, 2016** for the General Election. Absentee ballots will NOT be available at City Hall to vote in person. Applications are available on-line on the City website (Election tab), at City Hall, 6031 Main Street, or in person at the county where you live:

The compost site on Elm Street/CR 33 is scheduled to close **early November** until about April 15th, *depending on the weather.* **You do not need to check out a key at city hall.**

Items accepted: grass clippings, leaves and brush no larger than 3” in diameter. All bags used to transport composting must be removed.
